I John 1:1-10; 2:1-6

Answer the questions on a separate sheet of paper. Be sure to write your name, date, assignment, and teacher's name in the top right corner of your paper.

Monday

1. The Book of 1 John is written to give believers assurance of their salvation. How do we know this from 1 John 5:13?
2. 1 John has a series of tests that show whether or not a person is saved. What is the result of knowing we have fellowship with God and Jesus Christ? Read 1 John 1:4.
3. Read 1 John 1:5. What does it mean that God is light and that in Him is no darkness at all?
4. God is righteous. If a person says he has a close relationship with God and enjoys the things of God, but he lives a life of sin, is he telling the truth (1 John 1:6)?
5. According to 1 John 1:7, what do we have to do to have fellowship with God?

Tuesday

1. If a person says he has no sin (that he is a good person), who is he deceiving (1 John 1:8)?
2. A saved person will on occasion sin. What does John say a believer will do when he has committed a sin (1 John 1:9)?
3. What does God do when a believer does this?
4. According to 1 John 1:10, will a saved person cover up his sin and deny that he has done something wrong?

Thursday

1. Does the fact that believers can confess their sin mean that God wants them to sin all they want (1 John 2:1)?
2. Read 1 John 2:3. How does a person know if he is saved?
3. Read 1 John 2:4. If a person says he is saved but regularly disobeys Scripture, what does John call him?
4. Will a saved person live his life like Jesus lived (obediently) (1 John 2:6)?
5. What if a person does not live his life like Christ? What do we conclude?
